Mr. David Striebinger made the motion to approve the Superintendent's recommendations for employment listed on the April 1, 2021 to April 30, 2021 Personnel Ratification Report. Mr. David Striebinger made the motion that the Board of Education approve Amendment #1 with M.B. Kahn Construction for an early steel and lab casework package at Battery Creek High School in the amount of \$935,509. The motion was seconded by Colonel Richard Geier. The motion passed 10/0.

Mr. David Striebinger made the motion that the Board of Education approve Amendment #3 with Jumper Carter Sease Architects which authorizes an amount of \$668,011 for Bluffton High School referendum projects. The motion was seconded by Mr. Earl Campbell. The motion passed 10/0.

Mr. David Striebinger made the motion that the Board of Education approve Amendment #22 with M.B. Kahn Construction for the turf field at Bluffton High School which authorizes an amount of \$1,385,593. The motion was seconded by Mr. Melvin Campbell. The motion passed 10/0.

Mr. David Striebinger made the motion that the Board of Education approve Amendment #20 with M.B. Kahn Construction for HVAC work at Bluffton High School in the amount of \$976,838. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Cathy Robine. The motion passed 10/0.

Mr. David Striebinger made the motion that the Board of Education approve Amendments 11 & 12, which total \$552,717 with Contract Construction. Amendment 11 is for mechanical work associated with HVAC upgrades in the amount of \$299,777. Amendment 12 is for façade and electrical work associated with HVAC upgrades in the amount of \$252,940. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Ingrid Boatright. The motion passed 10/0.

Mr. Melvin Campbell made the motion that the Board approve the agenda and waive Board Policy GC-2.11.d.17 Adjournment and extend the meeting past 9:15 p.m. The motion was seconded by Colonel Richard Geier. The motion passed 9/0/1. William Smith abstained from the vote.
