

Issues for Consideration – Approved by Board on March 19, 2011

1. Decisions for changes in student assignment be made no later than October 1 of each year for following school year. Vote: 10-1 (Bush)
2. Limit programmatic transfers to definable selection criteria as specified on the Transfer Request Form and establish a cap for transfers within each of these program areas. Vote: 11-0
3. Maximize usage of instruction spaces. Vote: 11-0
4. Vote: 11-0 Adopt the following:

90%	- capacity level	- no additional students
75%-89%	- target level	- still able to accept students
50%-74%	- growth level	- strong recruitment
< 50%	- closure level	- consideration for closing
5. Close programmatic transfers to schools equal to or >90% full. Vote: 10-1 (Carbiener)
6. Consider closing sections of buildings using a cost benefit analysis (on or before April 15). Vote: 10-1 (Rivers)
7. Allow employee courtesy only at beginning of the year or when they enroll their child. Vote: 1-10
8. Carefully examine employee courtesy requests. Vote: 8-3 (Wilson, Carbiener, Morello)
9. In spring 2012 review transfer requests and policy for 2012-2013 school year. Vote: 10-1 (Morello)
10. Develop elementary programmatic selections to attract students to under capacity schools to bring diversity, close achievement gap and increase enrollment in 2012-2013 Vote: 10-1 (Carbiener)
