# Hilton Head Island High School wins Carlisle Cup

For the eighth consecutive year, Hilton Head Island High School has received top statewide honors for its athletic programs. The Carlisle Cup is bestowed by the South Carolina Athletic Administrators Association to the state's top overall athletic programs in each high school classification. Motion to approve the first addendum to an amended and restated affiliation agreement concerning ACE. Board discussion but no vote. Motion to move the agenda item to Friday's work session with the provision that if Dr. Berg and Dr. Lovecchio have not met and Dr. Lovecchio is not available, the discussion will be moved again. Motion approved.
