Dr. Berg introduced Dr. Jerome McKibben of McKibben Demographic Research LLC, who presented a demographic report on Beaufort County and addressed the Board's questions. Three key takeaways from Dr. McKibben's presentation were: Beaufort County essentially is composed of five school districts operating as one, divided by a river, which makes new construction and building maintenance more difficult; the district's school choice program makes facilities planning more difficult; and the district should keep an eye on home sales.

Planning Coordinator Carol Crutchfield introduced Community Project Review Committee members, who provided the Board with an update on school visits, and security and renovation estimates. Board discussion.
